

About the test

What it tests

The *Oxford Placement Test* has two sections – *Use of English* and *Listening*.

The *Use of English* section assesses students' knowledge of grammatical form and vocabulary.

The *Listening* section assesses students' general listening ability.

Both sections test how well students understand the meaning of what is being communicated, which is an excellent indicator of general language ability.

How it works

The *Oxford Placement Test* is computer adaptive, which means that the test adjusts the difficulty of questions based on the student's responses. This makes it more motivating and ensures that it gives a more precise measurement than traditional placement tests.


Answers are automatically marked after each task, giving you an instant result once the test is complete.

You can choose how long students have to complete the test (between 50 and 90 minutes), depending on their ability.

British or American English

The test is available in British and American English in four different combinations: 100% British English, 100% American English or a mix. For total flexibility, you don't have to choose the combination until you set up the test.



Test format


Use of English

The *Use of English* section focuses on grammatical form and meaning.



Listening

The *Listening* section tests how well students can understand communication in different contexts (such as university lectures, going shopping, and business meetings), depending on the CEFR level. There is a focus on explicit and implied meaning.


Step 2. Try a free trial test
